DIRECTIONS

Submit one photo of students engaged in non-school sponsored activities. Examples may include students at work (i.e. fast food cook, lifeguard), recreational sports (i.e. club soccer, rec league basketball), community service involvement (i.e. 4-H, soup kitchen volunteer), and etcetera.

Photo should be no larger than 8x10 inches and no smaller than 5x7, and may be submitted in either black and white or color. Photos should NOT be mounted. Photoshop may be used only for dodging or burning, removing scratches or other imperfections or correcting tones. Photos may not be altered in any way.

A complete cutline should be attached to the back of each photo to help the judge interpret the action in the photo. Cutlines will not be used for evaluating the photo, but must be included.
