This contest is different from the other contests in that it may be team-based. Each package should be produced by a team of no more than three students. Students involved with the winning entry will receive a certificate. First, second, and third place medals will be awarded to the winning schools.

Entry Package

Schools will submit a video news package on the school's senior class president or student body/government president. The video news package, which will focus on the student, should contain video, which is voiced-over by the reporter, at least two sound bites from the student, at least one sound bite from the student government sponsor, and a reporter stand-up. The package should be limited to a maximum of two minutes. Each package should involve a maximum of three individuals: a camera operator, talent and an editor. It may be edited using analog or digital equipment.
