**Do not** put your name on the entry. If you do, your entry will be disqualified.

Students are not to request help or advice from anyone other than the KSPA Executive Director. All work must be that of the contestant.

# **Assignment**

Submit one photo of students engaged in non-school sponsored activities. Examples may include students at work (i.e. fast food cook, lifeguard), recreational sports (i.e. club soccer, rec league basketball), community service involvement (i.e. 4-H, soup kitchen volunteer), and etcetera.

Photo should be no larger than  $8 \times 10$  inches and no smaller than  $5 \times 7$  inches. Photo may be submitted in either black and white or color. Photo should not be mounted. PhotoShop may be used only for correcting the technical clarity. Editing should maintain the integrity of the image's content and context. From the Society of Professional Journalists Code of Ethics:

" Journalists should . . . never distort the content of news photos or video. Image enhancement for technical clarity is always permissible."

A complete cutline should be attached to the back of your photo to help the judge interpret the action in the photo. Cutlines will not be used for evaluating the photo, but must be included.
