2013 KSPA STATE CONTEST

Assignment

Submit one photo of a student or students working at a job or jobs outside of school. These jobs can be at home, on a farm or at any sort of business that employs students.

Photo should be no larger than 8 x 10 inches and no smaller than 5 x 7 inches. Photo may be submitted in either black and white or color. Photo should not be mounted. Photo-shop may be used only for correcting the technical clarity. Editing should maintain the integrity of the image's content and context. From the Society of Professional Journalists Code of Ethics:

"Journalists should . . . never distort the content of news photos or video. Image enhancement for technical clarity is always permissible."

A complete cutline should be attached to the back of your photo to help the judge interpret the action in the photo. Cutlines will not be used for evaluating the photo, but must be included.
