Assignment

Using the information provided in the story below, design a photo illustration that is no larger than 8 inches wide by 10 inches high (though it can be smaller). It can be a vertical or horizontal. The photo illustration may be submitted in color or black and white, and should be printed on 8.5×11 -inch paper.

The photo used in the illustration must be student-produced and original to the contest. Students may use Photoshop or other software to alter the photo based on the assignment, but the original photo must be original to the contest, not downloaded from the Internet.

Specifications

A reporter for the Sunflower News has been given an assignment to write an article about how gossip and rumors affect high school students. The reporter has been encouraged to talk to a minimum of eight students and teachers for the story and do her best to get a variety of perspectives based on students' personal experiences. Create a photo illustration that could coordinate with a story on this topic.
