



2010 Jackie Engel Award

What is the Jackie Engel Award?

Created to honor the best of high school journalism advising in Kansas, the Jackie Engel Award is presented annually to an outstanding journalism adviser teaching in the state.

The award honors Engel, who dedicated much of her academic life to studying, writing and teaching high school journalism, and who was the first recipient of the award in 1990. Engel died in 2005, but her legacy of excellence lives on in this award.

Sponsored by the Kansas Associated Collegiate Press, the Jackie Engel Award is given to top candidates who have demonstrated excellence in journalism advising.

Who may apply?

Nominations of any Kansas Scholastic Press Association adviser are welcome from advisers themselves, or from students, colleagues or administrators on behalf of their advisers.

The 2010 winner will be honored at the KACP spring conference awards luncheon in April in Hutchinson, as well as at the KSPA state contest, May 1, in Lawrence.

How should nominations be handled?

Nomination packages should include (1) a cover letter from the person making the nomination, (2) a list of publications the candidate advises, (3) full address and telephone numbers of the applicant and nominator, (4) support materials, such as the candidate's resume and copies of the publication(s) advised, and (5) a minimum of three letters of support from students, colleagues, administrators, parents or journalists.

When is the due date?

The postmark deadline for applications is **Monday, March 1, 2010**.
