# **Description**

# **Assignment**

You need to create an ad that is 7" wide and 8" tall. This ARC tennis club ad should feature "Try it Thursday," a promotional event held every other Thursday by the ARC where Ad Astra High School students can try out a sport club for free. The ad may be submitted in color or black and white, and should be printed on 8.5 x 11-inch paper.

Also, since the tennis club is new, the ARC needs a logo for the club that will appeal to high school students and could be easily printed on a t-shirt for all new members. Your recommendations are needed. Include your suggested logo in the ad you create and on a separate 8.5 x 11-inch paper. You need to also submit a 50-word description of your logo design choices. Designs should be computer-generated and may incorporate clip art or other graphics to enhance the design.

### **Ad Elements**

The ARC would also like you to consider the following:

- Ad Astra students who join the tennis club will pay only \$15 (the membership fee for community members is \$30) and receive a free t-shirt (with your logo on it).
- Tennis is a fun recreational sport that is easy to learn and play.
- The club will travel to nearby cities to compete. AAHS students will have the chance to form teams and compete against rival John Brown High School teams.
- The ARC offers a variety of others sport clubs and leagues for students to join.
