Criteria for Journalism Educators

A. Noteworthy service to KSPA and to the education of student journalists

I) Significant number of students enrolled in the journalism program

2) Involvement in KSPA as a committee member, conference speaker, judge, author or officer

3) Active membership in regional or national associations

4) Recommendation by school administrators, other school personnel, professional media or former students active in professional journalism

5) Minimum of 10 years experience in the field

B. Outstanding personal achievement in student journalism

I) Speaking or teaching at journalism workshops

2) Judging contests for other states or in national competitions

3) Authorship of books or periodicals in state and national publications

4) Leadership of a national, state or regional journalism/adviser program

5) Innovation in the field of journalism education

C. Contribution to the field of student journalism

 Receipt of award(s) for achievement in education

2) Authorship of articles in national and state education organizations as an officer or a committee member

3) Serve as a mentor to new advisers in the field

Criteria for Members of the Professional Media

I) Participate in educational conferences, seminars, workshops and conventions

2) Financial and technical support of student publications

3) Individuals who have contributed significantly to the aims and goals of KSPA are also eligible for induction
