The Friend of KSPA Award recognizes a professional partner's efforts to support KSPA and scholastic journalism on a state or local level. The award is open to professional journalists, university and college educators, and any other professional who has contributed to the organization and its members and students. The recipient will receive a plaque and be honored at his/her workplace in the spring 2014. Letters of nomination may come from KSPA advisers and their students.

The nominee will be judged on the following three criteria:

- 1). Contribution of personal time and effort on behalf of scholastic journalism in Kansas.
- 2). Support of KSPA advisers in the community and/or state.
- 3). Support of students journalists' First Amendment rights.

Your letter of nomination should explain your relationship with the nominee and then explain in detail how the nominee meets the three criteria for the award. You may also include any supporting evidence, including a resume or CV of the nominee, other (no more than three) letters of recommendation and any links or copies of stories that describe the nominee's contributions to KSPA and scholastic journalism in Kansas.
