Assignment

Submit one photo of a student or students engaged in non-school sponsored activities. Examples may include students at work (i.e. waitress, child care, office assistant), recreational sports (i.e. club sports, rec league basketball, pick-up basketball game in student's driveway or at park), community service involvement (i.e. 4-H, Girls Scouts, soup kitchen volunteer, animal shelter volunteer), and etcetera.

Photo should be no larger than 8×10 inches and no smaller than 5×7 inches. Photo may be submitted in either black and white or color. Photo should not be mounted. Photoshop may be used only for correcting the technical clarity. Editing should maintain the integrity of the image content and context. From the Society of Professional Journalists Code of Ethics:

"Journalists should . . . never distort the content of news photos or video. Image enhanceent for technical clarity is always permissible."

A complete cutline should be **taped** to the back of your photo to help the judge interpret the action in the photo. Cutlines will not be used for evaluating the photo, but must be included.
