Emporia offers a wide variety of food, from burgers and pizza to Chinese food and sushi. Braum's has proved especially popular with student groups in the past.

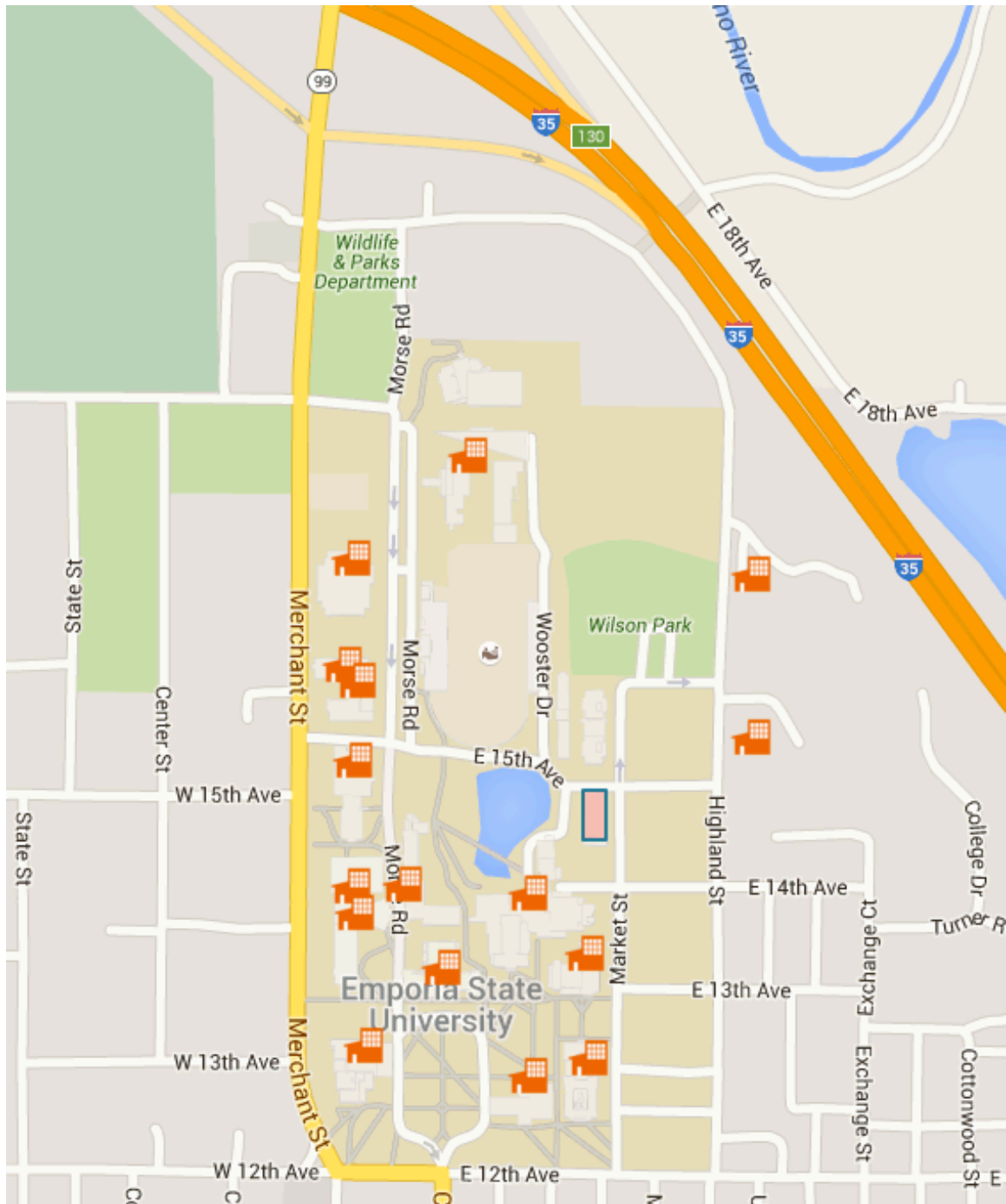
