

Parking

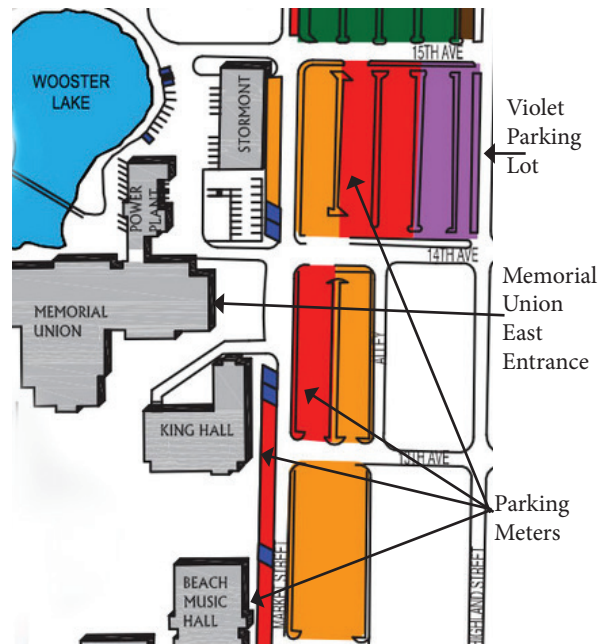
Please enter at the east entrance of the Memorial Union.

Busses can drop students off at these doors (use Market Street off of 12th).

Bus parking is available on the far north end of campus (by the soccer & football practice fields off of Highland Street).

You may purchase a \$2 daily parking pass for the nearby Violet Lots, if you are driving a car, van or light truck. Let us know in advance and we will have it waiting for you.

You may also use one of the parking meters (if there are any available). The meters cost \$2 for a 4-hour period.

Registration Desk The registration desk, on the first floor of Memorial Union (located at the East entrance), is open from 8 to 8:45 a.m. All schools need to be registered by 8:45 so we can stay on schedule. 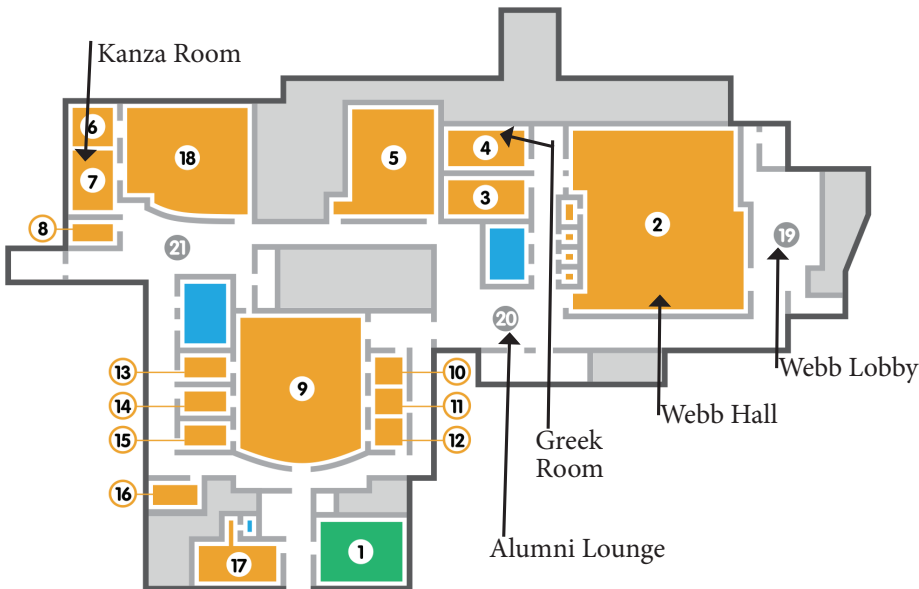
Personal listening devices, recording devices, personal computers and mobile devices are prohibited during the contest.
