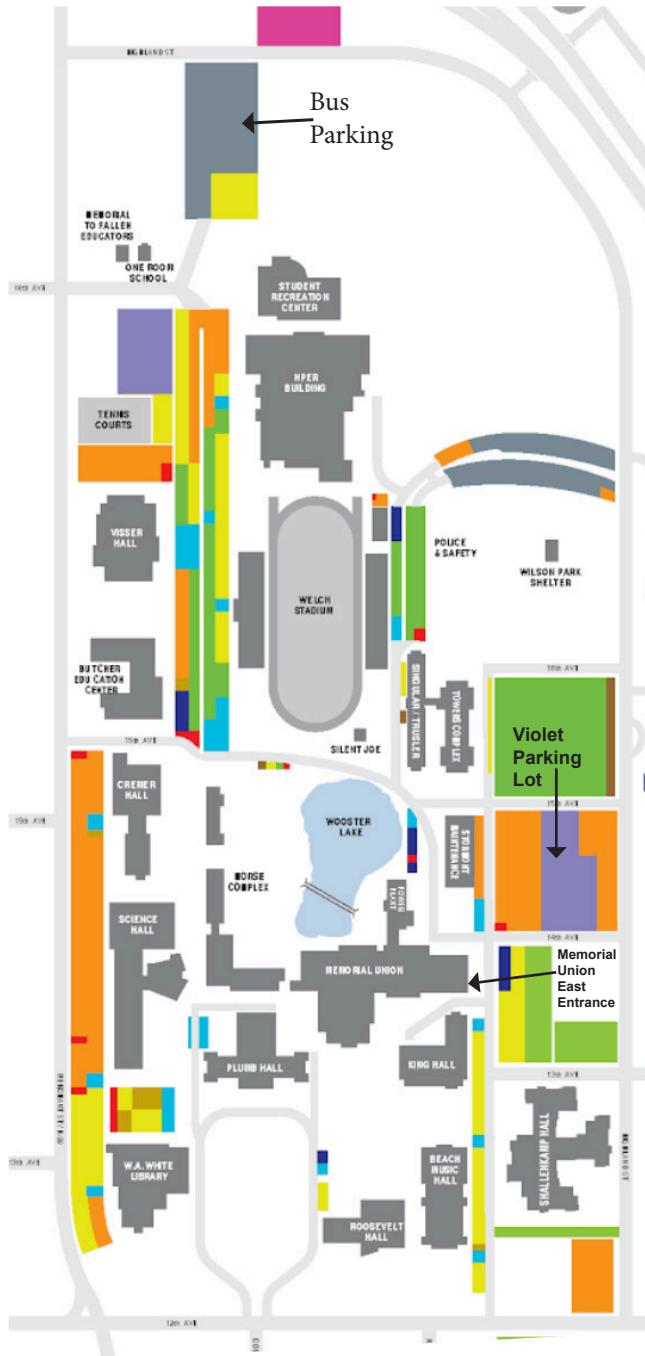
Parking

Please enter at the east entrance of the Memorial Union.

Registration Desk The registration will be on the second floor of Memorial Union is open from 8:30 to 9 a.m. All schools need to be registered by 9 am so we can stay on schedule. Judged Entries All entries will be mailed back to you after judging them. Contest results will be posted online on ksponline.org to get results. KSPA headquarters will post all results by the second week of March.

Schools will not bring any carry-in contests with you to the regional site. Advisers

Bring copies of your publications to share with others in the advisers' room (Greek Room). Also, bring any books, other items or ideas you want to discuss with your colleagues.

What to Bring

Don't forget pencils, pens and rulers. Students in writing categories will be evaluated on the basis of Associated Press Stylebook rules. They are permitted to bring a dictionary, thesaurus and AP stylebook.

Personal listening devices, recording devices, personal computers and mobile devices are prohibited during the contest.

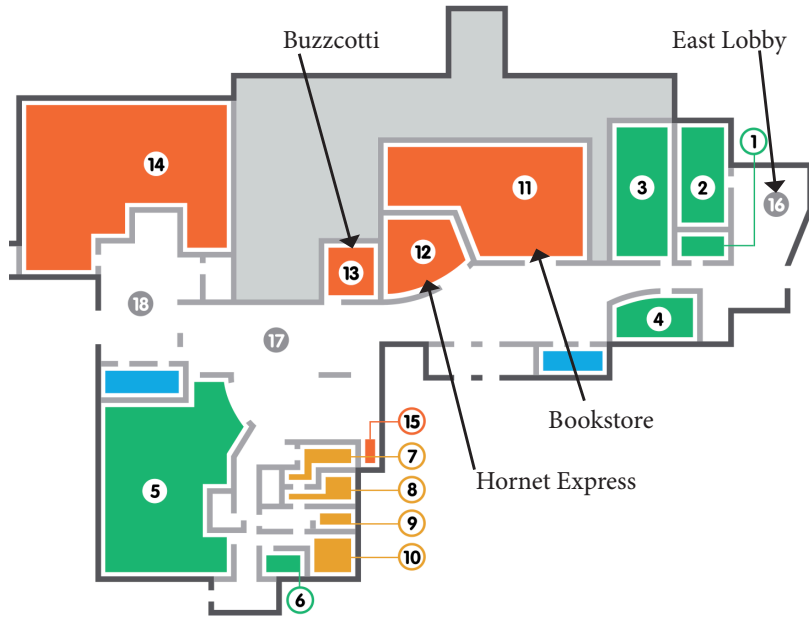

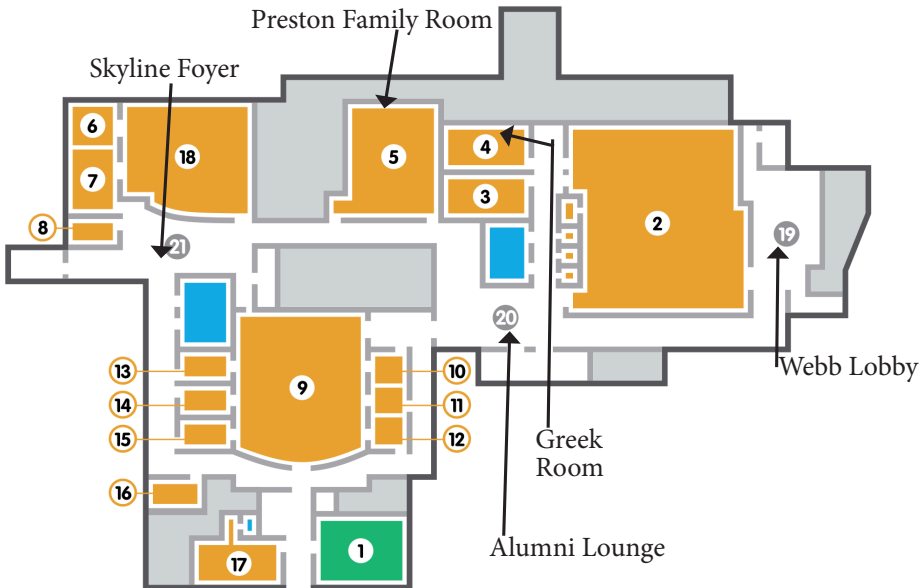
